

Western Australia's iconic black cockatoos are in crisis. Their numbers have fallen dramatically over the past few decades and all three species in the south-west of WA could become extinct in just 20 years unless something is done to protect their habitats. With the loss of the banksia woodlands on the Swan Coastal Plain to housing, Carnaby's Black Cockatoos have come to depend on the once vast exotic pine plantations on Perth's northern fringe.

This is a story with a Western Australian focus but a universal theme. The world's biodiversity stands at a crossroads with more than 1 million species currently facing extinction. Will we act in time to save them?

Self funded, Arnold built the movie set in his back shed and took the streets in a guerrilla style film making fashion for the location shoots to complete this low budget picture. Stephanie Davis is a Perth-based producer (Somedae Pictures) who has worked on many feature and short films including Lurking Woods, Tainted Getaway, Undiscovered Country and Jadai: The Broome Brawler. Stephanie also won an Out There development grant through ScreenWest for the LGBTQIA+ web series, Drag Alien Wrestling. Stephanie most recently produced the web series Love Me Lex.



Ruby Schmidt is a screen practitioner and producer with a background in factual and scripted content. Ruby completed a Bachelor of Laws in 2013 before spending two years as a Development Executive at Carbon Creative, working across a diverse slate of projects including League Nation Live (NITV), and Sesame Street Season 47 interstitials. Most recently Ruby was an Associate Producer on the AACTA nominated feature documentary Brock: Over the Top, and produced the documentary General Hercules.

Sarah Legg is an established emerging Boorloo filmmaker with experience in theatre, film, photography, freelance video and photo, film tutoring and teaching, academic writing and judging. Perun has just finished directing and co-writing the recently-released NITV docu-series *Our Law.* He has also directed Prospero Production's immersive dome film *Star Dreaming* as well as written for the AFL documentary *Noongar Footy Magic* and ABC web-series *Aussie Rangers*.

Perun has also written and directed several short films including Indigenous horror anthology Dark Place - The Shore (ABC), Blight (ABC), Fighter (NITV), and Shadows of Displacement (NITV). Perun's films have screened at a multitude of film festivals, including - Hot Docs, imagineNATIVE, St Tropez International Film Fest and Sydney Film Fest to name a few.



SURVIVORS OF WADJEMUP

D/W/P Glen Paul Stasiuk

Wadjemup or Rottnest Island is sacred to Aboriginal people. For almost one hundred years between 1838 and 1931 Wadjemup was a prison for at least 3,670 Aboriginal men and boys. More than 370 men never made it off the island and are now buried in unmarked graves on the island. They were fathers. They were sons. They were brothers. They were husbands. They were never to see their homelands and family again. Their spirits are part of this island, and for those that got off the island, their descendants now proudly tell their story.
